## 1. What's New in Version 3.11.0

This version of ViewPoint provides support for underlying software updates and also an update to support STF valid-values.

- **Underlying Software Update** Previous versions of ViewPoint were supported by Java version 1.4 and Weblogic 8.1. This version of ViewPoint now supports Java 1.6 and Weblogic 10.3. Previous versions of Java and Weblogic are no longer supported.
- **SSL Certificate Requirement** Based on the underlying software updates, an SSL Certificate is now required. Clients must either obtain a certificate from a trusted authority (e.g. VeriSign) or have Octagon create a self-signed certificate. Refer to Section 5 for details.
- **STF Valid Values** The current version of the FDA STF valid values now allows pre-clinical-study-report as a file-tag, whereas previous versions did not. The current valid values version also no longer contains the individual-subject-data-listing file-tag. Changes have been implemented to the Validator to support the current valid values file, including the removal of validation “[1138] No Pre-Clinical Study reports are in the STF XML files” from the available configurations since it no longer applies.

## 2. Documentation for Version 3.11.0

No updates have been done to the printed guides or online help for this version of ViewPoint.

## 3. Limitations in Version 3.11.0

The following limitations are associated with this version of ViewPoint.

- **Java and WebLogic Versions Compatibility** As of version 3.11.0, ViewPoint is no longer compatible with Java versions prior to 1.6.0 and with WebLogic versions prior to 10.3.

- **Overlapping Labels in Reviewer** The upper and lower tab labels display in such a way that either partially or completely obscures the label text. The label icons are clearly visible and the roll-over descriptions display properly. There is no impact to functionality.

- **Null Pointer Exception Error Encountered While Importing** A null pointer exception error is generated while importing an eCTD sequence into a non-eCTD project and while importing an eCTD sequence into a fixed-eCTD project. However, the import full structure operation still completes successfully.

- **Resource Estimator Cannot be Installed on Alternate Ports** Resource Estimator cannot be installed on any ports other than 9001.

- **Resource Estimator Queue Not Accessible** Resource Estimator does not function with this version.
